This compilation of "A Harmony of the Evangelists" lists the principal events during Yahshua's 3½ year-ministry and is not intended to present a chronological verse-by-verse annotation from each of the four Evangel accounts. "A Harmony of the Evangelists" is intended to be an ancillary aid in the presentation of a series of discourses before the Assembly of Mark's Evangel account, and where applicable, parallel narratives from the other 3 Evangel accounts are employed to support or embellish Mark's record. Thus, while every effort was made to present sequential verse-by-verse entries from the four parallel Evangel accounts, emphasis on Mark's Evangel has occupied the compiler's attention.

The inquirer's attention is directed to the entries under "**The Passion Week.**" Of interest, was a demarcation of Yahshua's daily ministry activities from the Evangel Records. One will note that Yahshua was earnest in completing the Work assigned Him by His Father, Yahweh. Constantinian religion (Christianity) has not generally regarded the intensity of the King's Business during these days preceding the Days of Unleavened Bread. Neither has It given much tribute to His appointment as that "Passover Lamb;" nor yet, appreciated His death was set to mark "an appointed time," the Feast of Unleavened Bread instituted in the Old Testament Torah (Exodus, chapter 12) and thus, Its ignorant disregard of Passover and the following First Day of Unleavened Bread as a Sabbath distinguished from the weekly Sabbath. Hence, the reason for Its employment of 'inclusive reckoning' that's compressed Yahshua's three-night and three-day interment into two nights and one day, annulling His declaration that "as Jonah was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth" (Matt. 12:39).

Lastly, it is noteworthy to acknowledge the Evangelist John's conclusion to his Evangel –

And many other signs truly did Yahshua in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this Book ... the which, if they should be written every one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written ... But these are written, that ye might believe that Yahshua is the Messiah, the Son of Eloha; and that believing ye might have life through His Name, Amen. John 20:30, 21:25, 20:21.
